Job Description:

The Writer and Copy Editor will contribute to “Transforming the Field Education Landscape: Intersections of Research and Practice in Canadian Social Work Field Education” (funded by a SSHRC Partnership Grant) led by Project Director Dr. Julie Drolet. The goal of this partnership is to integrate research and practice in the preparation of the next generation of social workers by developing partnered research training initiatives that enhance student and trainee research practice knowledge and applied skill development. The main responsibilities include proofreading and editing manuscripts, book chapters, and reports prior to submission for publication, and assisting with the preparation of presentations, webinars, project related communications, and other duties as required.
